- Girls learn to exhibit compassion and kindness as they learn to serve others through missions projects.
- Girls participate in God's work throughout the world as they pray for missionaries.
- Girls gain confidence and self-esteem in a learning atmosphere of acceptance.
- Girls learn to focus on others rather than on themselves.
- Girls develop a strong foundation for a Christian and missions lifestyle.
