There were 918 participants at Eagle Eyrie Conference Center for Mom and Me 2008. Girls and their mothers from across Virginia learned about *Incredible India* through learning activities of music and dance, cooking, and crafts.

The weekend missions project supported Hope Tree Family Services (formerly known as Virginia Baptist Children's Home and Family Services) requiring two vehicles to transport the generous contribution of personal care items for the ministry to at-risk children, youth, and their families; and to adults with developmental disabilities and their families. An offering of \$3067 will support the ministry at the Precious Children's Home in India.

Kathryn has a passion and heart for missions and presented a creative devotion which challenged the girls and mothers to knit hats for premature babies. Located in the Chapel, the Mom's Class focused on *being still* and encouraged the Moms to find at least five minutes everyday to devote to solitude, quietness, and stillness in order to listen to God's voice.

A Scavenger Hunt sent the girls and moms throughout the Eagle Eyrie Campus searching for clues that shared facts about William Carey, an 18th century missionary to India and considered the *Father of Missions*.
